# VEHICLE STATUS

### Vehicle Status - An Assets Management service in Volvo Connect

Volvo Connect is one single interface for your fleet and business where you can manage vehicles, trailers and all other assets of importance.

#### Facilitating vehicle management

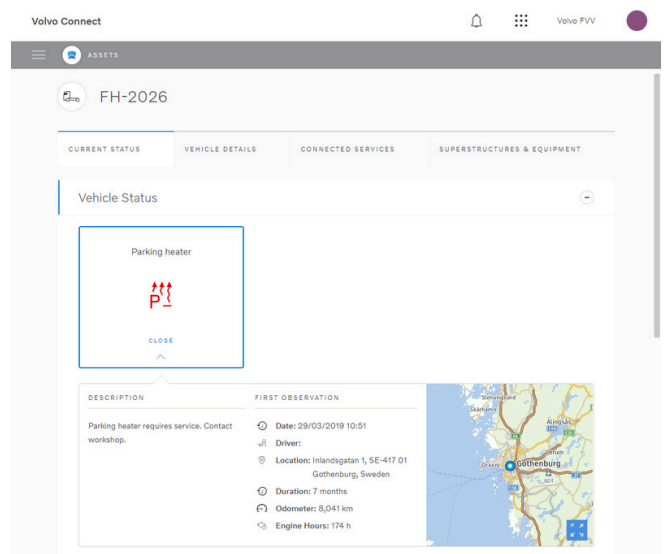
Vehicle Status shows information related to the vehicle's instrument cluster and facilitates the short- and long-term vehicle management for the fleet manager. The overview in Volvo Connect presents the number of warnings and alarms in the fleet with a drill-down tool to identify the status for each individual vehicle.

The service monitors the status of the warning and alarm lamps in the vehicle's instrument cluster. Information and possible actions are presented for each vehicle including the additional data:

- Date of occurrence
- Address and position on map
- Driver name
- Odometer
- Engine hours (diesel/gas vehicles) or motor hours (electric vehicles)
- Duration of the warning or alarm

- Warnings and alarms from the instrument cluster of each vehicle in the fleet.
- Notifications of Vehicle Status events in real time.
- Instrument cluster information such as light malfunction, oil pressure (diesel/gas vehicles) or worn brake pads and more.
